do in post 16

In post 16, we do things differently to what others do in the main school.

The things we do in post 16 will prepare you for the future. For example you get sent out to go shopping on your own and catch the bus.

You will get support from your teacher and eventually build up confidence to do it on your own.

We do enterprise while we make products to sell for people and make money for an end of year trip. Examples of what my class made are candles, chicks made out of egg boxes and cushions made out of shirts.

What we also do in post 16 is go to the gym. A teacher will take you to the gym to run, jog and walk you back.

You can do work experience when you get out of class for a day and go somewhere local and help the staff. Examples of places you can go are Halfords, People charity shop and the school site.

On Tuesdays and Thursday mornings until lunch everyone has to do English and Maths. We do an hour of English starting from 9:30 until 10:30. After break, we do Maths up until lunch.

The main thing we all do in post 16 is unit work.

It is the main qualification you get at the end of the year. You are taught how to behave in the workplace, presentation skill what to wear in the workplace and CV writing. The classes in post 16 are relatively small with one teacher and three TAs which means you get more help.
